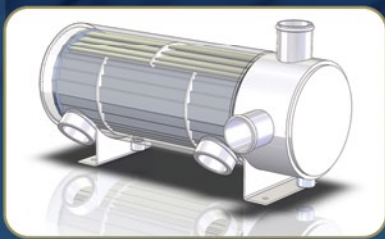
In this Newsletter, we decided to focus on some of the founding qualities that made SKL what it is today: innovation and flexibility.

As a manufacturer, our main goal is to focus our services on you, so you can offer better service to **your own customers**, and we are **pleased** to help you.

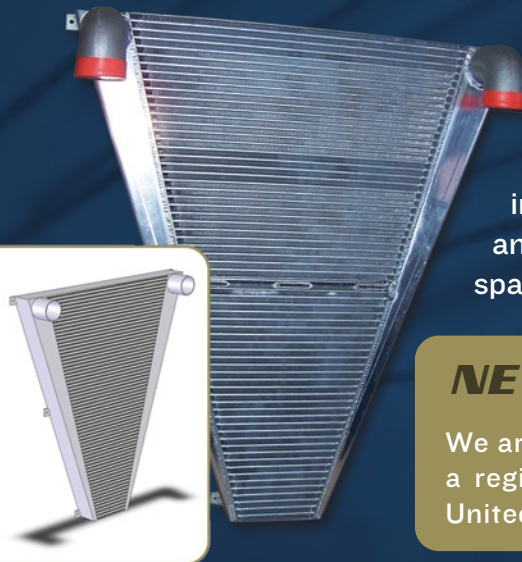
First example :

In order to meet the demand of one of their client, a repair shop requested from us to design and manufacture a tube in shell cooler, allowing a heavy vehicle to convert its manual transmission to an automatic transmission. After analyzing the cooling needs and space requirements, we were able to fully satisfy our client within 2 weeks time, including delivery.



Second example :

Some customers ask us (sometimes without knowing it) challenges which we never faced! One of our costumers, working in the transport industry needed an inter-cooler which married the engine hood. The unconventional geometry made it impossible to install a normal shape inter-cooler. So, after dimensional analysis, we designed and manufactured an inter-cooler which meets the cooling requirements despite the space constraints all that within 2 weeks delivery included.
